Amendment to the Request for Proposal (RFP)

for Integrated Public Safety Information Solution

The following items were amended from the original RFP and are included in the current RFP (Version 2) for review and reference when preparing your bid or proposal:

1. All page numbers referred to in the Table of Contents on page ii have been revised to fit the amendments made.
2. Vendor Instructions, Section (2) two, General Requirements, page 3 has been changed to state, General Considerations and some of the bullet points have either been moved into technical or functional questions, removed or reworded to explain the consideration.
 - *Relational Database (Microsoft SQL 2005/2008 preferred)* has been reworded and moved to Technical Question #43 and #44.
 - *Integration to leverage desktop productivity tools such as Microsoft Office Suite* has been moved to Functional Question #74.
 - *Widely accepted development foundation (i.e., VisualStudio.Net, J2EE, or WebSphere)* has been removed from this section due to being a Technical Question #1.
 - *CAD Mapping (under the core software applications required to meet the requirements of this RFP)* has been reworded to explain the consideration and requirement.
3. Proposal Form, Section (9) nine, formally page 7, now page 6 has been reworded to inquire *the number of in house employees that are certified in the administration and maintenance of the proposed database solution.*
4. Software Requirements, Minimum Requirements, number (3) three, page 9 has been removed and reworded as technical question #45 inquiring if the vendor is a *Certified Microsoft Solution Partner.*
5. Software Requirements, Minimum Requirements, number (4) four, page 9 has been removed and reworded as technical question #46 inquiring if the *vendors proposed system can leverage Microsoft technology and operate on MS2008 server operating system for its database and application execution.*

6. Software Requirements, Minimum Requirements, number (5) five, page 9 regarding *the proposed system should use Microsoft's SQL 2005 or Microsoft SQL 2008 database (preferred)* has been removed.
7. Technical Question #34, page 16 has been reworded to further explain the question for the vendor regarding the *phone book data being converted from an excel format into the CAD.*
8. *Jasco anticipates 6-8 CAD workstations (1 of which will be used for training) and 50-60 mobile clients of which about half are logged on at a given time.*
